



Musculoskeletal Management Program Provider Education Webinars

In keeping with our commitment of promoting continuous quality improvement, Wellcare will be expanding its partnership with National Imaging Associates Inc. Evolent Health and its affiliates and subsidiaries are collectively referred to as “Evolent.” to implement a Musculoskeletal (MSK) Management Program effective March 1, 2024. This program will include prior authorization for non-emergent MSK procedures, including: outpatient, interventional pain management (IPM) services specific to spinal cord stimulators; and inpatient and outpatient hip, knee, shoulder, lumbar, and cervical spine surgeries. This decision is consistent with industry-wide efforts to ensure clinically appropriate quality of care and to manage the increasing utilization of these services.
