



Medication Reviews Are Crucial to Member Health Outcomes

Did you know?

Medication Reconciliation Post-Discharge (MRP): This HEDIS® measure ensures that members who are discharged from the hospital have their medications reviewed by a prescribing practitioner, clinical pharmacist or registered nurse within 30 days after discharge.

What do you need to do?

- Reach out to members and see them within 30 days after a discharge
- Document in the patient's chart indicating:
 - Current Medication List
 - Member's discharge medications were reviewed with the current outpatient medications and/or
 - No medications were prescribed upon discharge
- Send a claim to WellCare for the services above. The suggested codes for these services include:
 - CPT Code 99495, 99496: Transitional Care Management Services AND
 - CPT II code 1111F: Medication Reconciliation

These actions can make a big difference to our members. Together, we can deliver the best possible care to our members – your patients.

What is WellCare doing?

- Our Discharge Planning, Pharmacy or Care Management Teams are attempting to reach out to your members and perform the Medication Reconciliation by phone.

If we are successful in reaching members who are your patients, WellCare will fax you the results of these calls. We ask that you include this fax in your medical record and review these medications with members when you see them.

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
